Wine Notes

Aromas of ripe red berries, cherries and raspberries, with floral undertones of violet and a hint of spice. Medium-bodied with lively acidity and silky tannins. Elegant and well-balanced with a vibrant mineral finish. An excellent representation of Riberia Sacra.

Losada Fernandez vineyards are located in Ribeira Sacra, which is named for the many chapels that dot the rugged landscape. The vineyards are planted on stone terraces with the steep slopes of the canyons of the rivers Sil and Mino with the indigenous red mencia grape. The rivers bring relief to the hot summers and cold winters. The incredible terraces cut out of the mountainsides, recalls the Roman era in which labor was plentiful. Today, all the Losada Fernandez vineyards and terraces remain maintained on perfect condition. Every vineyard is equipped with a "lift-system" to allow the collection of grapes without breaking for the vinification process to begin at the Cellar. Also, all the vineyards have mountain spring water to facilitate farming. All have direct access by paved roads.

Vinification:

Following a meticulous manual harvest in small boxes, the grapes undergo complete destemming, crushing, and spontaneous fermentation with indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks. The wine is then bottled directly from the tank without undergoing any fining or filtration processes.
