Terra Alta is a small wine region, in Catalonia, reaching for attention with distinctive wines based primarily on indigenous grapes. Edetaria is among the wineries leading the way. Joan LLiberia vinifies only its own estate family vineyards, many of which are more than 50 years old.

Edetaria is committed to taking Garnatxa Blanca to the next level. Working with seafloor soil types (Tapas, Tapas blanc, and Panal) each with their own microclimate, Joan Angel is dedicated to making wines packed with minerality and freshness in a Mediterranean climate. Unique terroirs, making unique garnatxa wines.

Via Terra Selection Blanc 2019 is a pure Garnatxa blanca wine embodying Mediterranean richness and freshness. Beautiful pear on the nose, lush palate and a bright saline finish. Average yearly production:



Harvest: September 5th-20th. Hand picked grapes in small 15kg. cases. Low temperature storage for 48 hours at 3°-5°C. Fermentation: 48 hours natural gravity debourbage, followed by fermentation at 16°C for 15 days. Aging: After fermentation assemblage takes place followed by aging in stainless steel tanks to achieve creaminess and delicacy.
